



Do you take action when you see someone in need of help? Are you willing to pitch in to help our community during an earthquake, fire or flood?

The Community Emergency Response Training (CERT) is a two day class that teaches you how to assist emergency personnel in an disaster. The City has 12-14 emergency personnel on duty at any one time. In a City of 14,000 residents in a large scale emergency, that will not be enough.

The basic CERT class is hands on and is taught by southern Marin fire department personnel. Topics include search and rescue, triage and disaster first aid, and fire prevention and suppression. Once you have completed the basic class, you join the Mill Valley CERT team and become eligible for advanced trainings such as the evacuation drill held in Cascade Canyon last May. We currently have 250 CERT grads in the City.
